#2: The 2nd Lesson

I. Not OK - The prophet complains about God's previous revelation-
Hab. 1:12-17

- A. God is Holy.
- B. God ordains authority.
- C. The prophet questions God.
- D. The prosperity of the wicked is temporary - Ps. 37:1-7.
- E. Our only lasting hope is in God and eternity.
- F. God still plans to bring judgment upon Israel through the Babylonians.

II. Walk This Way - Our calling is to walk by faith - Hab. 2:1-5.

- A. God's decrees always come to pass.
- B. The world mocks God's decrees - 2 Pet. 3:9; Matt. 27:27-44.
- C. Believers walk by faith.
- D. Faith is understanding, belief and trust.

III. Time to Pay - The Babylonians will eventually fall - Hab. 2:6-20.

- A. God decrees that the Babylonians will ultimately fall.
- B. The prosperity of the wicked is temporary.
- C. God's kingdom will ultimately prevail.
- D. Our trust should be in God alone, not in idols.
