Re-gathering Information

Updated August 28, 2020

Great news! Our state and local government has given us the green light to re-gather together as a church family. We want you to understand that your safety and health are of primary importance. We know that there will be some who are ready to jump in with both feet and others who have concerns and are understandably hesitant. Please know that there is no pressure for anyone to come back into our building until you are ready. With deep respect we encourage seniors as well as people with underlying medical conditions to feel free to remain at home. Also, if anyone in your family has a fever, feels ill or has been recently exposed to someone with Covid-19, we request that you stay home. We will continue to live stream our worship service each week. We are taking precautions to make sure our buildings are sanitized and touch free. We want you to be able to focus on God while you are here and not on germs. Please read the list of precautions below.

- The governor is recommending we limit capacity to 50%. For Trinity's worship center that is equal to 220 people.
- The front doors will remain locked until 9:45 a.m. Please do not congregate near the entry doors but wait patiently in your car till the doors open.
- We ask that you enter the worship center and sit down upon entering the building. Greet one another with a wave and a smile. Please avoid all physical contact. For the safety of yourself and others, we request that you do not congregate in the foyer.
- Please feel free to bring your own beverage with you, as the coffee bar and Connection Center will be closed.
- Our seating will be organized with 6 ft of social distancing between family groups. We ask that you practice social distancing at all times while at church.
- The state of Louisiana is encouraging the use of face coverings. We request that everyone over the age of 2 wear a face covering in the church building. Please bring your favorite. There will be a limited number available if you forget.
- Please bring your own Bible and pen as these will be removed from the worship center.
- Bulletins will be placed on each chair.
- Offerings—please use the giving boxes in the foyer of the main building, the FDC, and the worship center, as we will not pass the offering plates. Or, continue to give online.
- Restrooms will be open in both the main building and FDC. We will have an attendant sanitizing faucets, counters, and other high touch areas while the building is in use.
- Upon dismissal, we request that you exit the buildings. For the safety of yourself and others, we ask that you do not congregate in the worship center, Summit, or building foyers after the service. Please visit outside.
- **Nursery resumed on July 19th and is available for newborns to 4 years of age. Sunday school classes will resume on July 26th. There will be two age groups of Sunday School classes: pre-K through 2nd, and 3rd – 5th grade. Youth service is available for students 6th – 12th in the Youth Building on Sundays. Youth will be dismissed from the Worship Center immediately following the worship and offering portion of the service.**
