Creating Ripples

Dawn: Jesus begins His Ministry

- Jesus withdraws to Galilee. (Matt. 4:12)
 - He continues where John the Baptist had left off.
 - His ministry could gain some momentum.
 - Galilee was less dangerous than Jerusalem.
- He begins in the territory of Zebulun and Naphtali. (Matt 4:13)
 - His location was a fulfillment of prophecy.
 - He was a Light in the darkness.
- Jesus begins preaching about the Kingdom. (Matt. 4:17)
 - He uses same words as John the Baptist. (Matt. 3:1-2)
 - This signified connection between John and Christ.
 - Jesus stuck to the basics.

Drawn: Jesus Calls the First Disciples

- Jesus walks by the Sea of Galilee. (Matt. 4:18)
 - The inhabitants are less cultivated or refined.
 - Jesus chooses the least likely. (1 Cor. 1:27-29)
- Jesus uses language they can understand. (Matt. 4:19)
- The disciples are faithful, available and teachable. (Matt. 4:20)
- Jesus spells out the cost of discipleship. (Matt. 16:24)

Phenomenon: Jesus Ministers to Great Crowds

- Jesus knows how to draw a crowd. (Matt. 4:23)
- His fame grows. (Matt. 4:24-25)
 - We can be intimidated by the size of Jesus' ministry.
- Ministry is accomplished one conversation at a time.
- Ministry is accomplished one life at a time.
- God takes your offering and multiplies it.
